- filled-out Exercise Practicum !

‘the EM1 requirement’ (signature, seal, and passed C) is written in the student INDEX.

**NOTES:**

Student in groups 9 and 10 that have already achieved the requirements for EM1 (passed C and have a signed and sealed index) do not need to attend again lab exercises and do the Colloquium, since the requirements achieved once are valid throughout the entire studies !

Older students attending years 2 and 3 of the Faculty, that have not achieved the requirements for EM1 and are not enlisted for the first academic year but do possess a ‘contract’ for a repeated course EM1, are under obligation to attend lab exercises together with groups 9 and 10; they shall be added onto these group lists and shall do the Colloquium accordingly.
